

Brief about the Central library of Lalit Chandra Bharali College

- Total Area of the Library is 245 sq. meter.
- The Library is partially automated and automated circulation along with OPAC was introduced in the year 2011 to facilitate seamless services. The Central Library is equipped with two Lenovo Think Server as SOUL server and Digital Library Server. Two computers are used in circulation Desk. Two computers are used as OPAC nodes. The office of the Librarian functions with a single computer for multipurpose works.
- Nine numbers of CCTV have been installed in the central library premises as a security measure.
- Proper arrangement of books has been done using 21st edition of DDC scheme on the racks;
- OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) services are offered for easy accessibility to the books.
- Library has a separate reading room for students and staff with a seating capacity of 50+10=60
- It is proposed for extension of the area of the central library in the old Principals office which has already been shifted to the newly constructed building Block-C and expecting to increase the seating capacity for users including Reference and Periodical Section in a full-fledged manner.
- It has a facility of Digital library Section specially for Institutional Repository (IR) and also for accessing E-resources, and the like where 10 users can be accommodated.
- The library has remote access facility for e-books and e-journals through NLIST programme under INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar.
- The Library is partially automated and automated circulation along with OPAC was introduced in the year 2011 to facilitate seamless services. - A Library orientation programme is organized especially for the newcomers of the college, namely students/ staff at the beginning of the session.
- Library has a Rare book and Manuscript section.
- It has a section of Special collection of books on Dr. Bhupen Hazarika and Prof. Mamani Roysom Goswami.
- The central library has its extension center in Central Jail, Guwahati where 164 books were donated to the Bapuji Puthibharal inside the Jail premises along with a book shelf, reading tables and chairs. The central library has also undertaken the responsibility of providing two daily newspapers (one English and one Assamese) on a regular basis for the benefit of its inmates.
