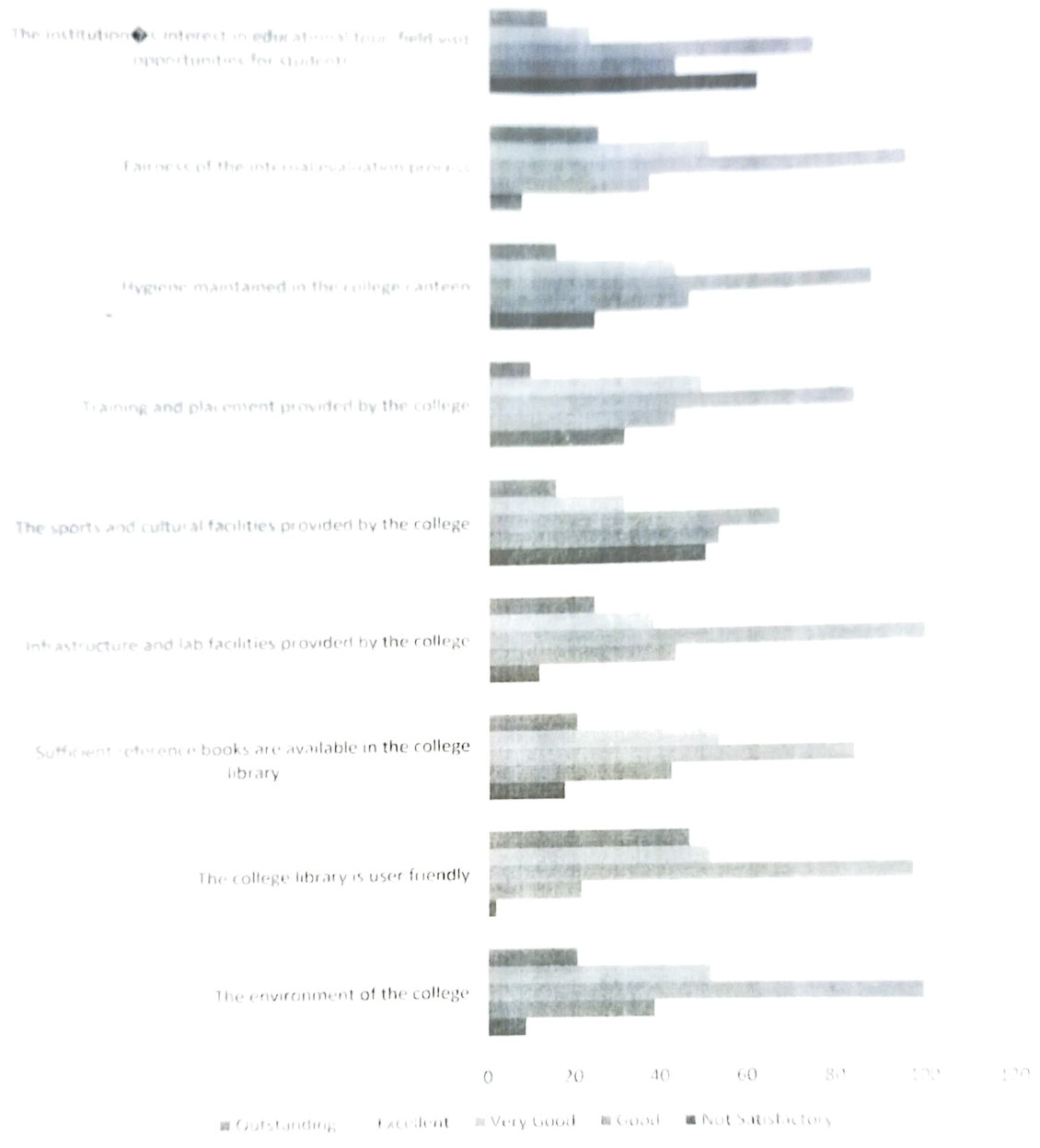

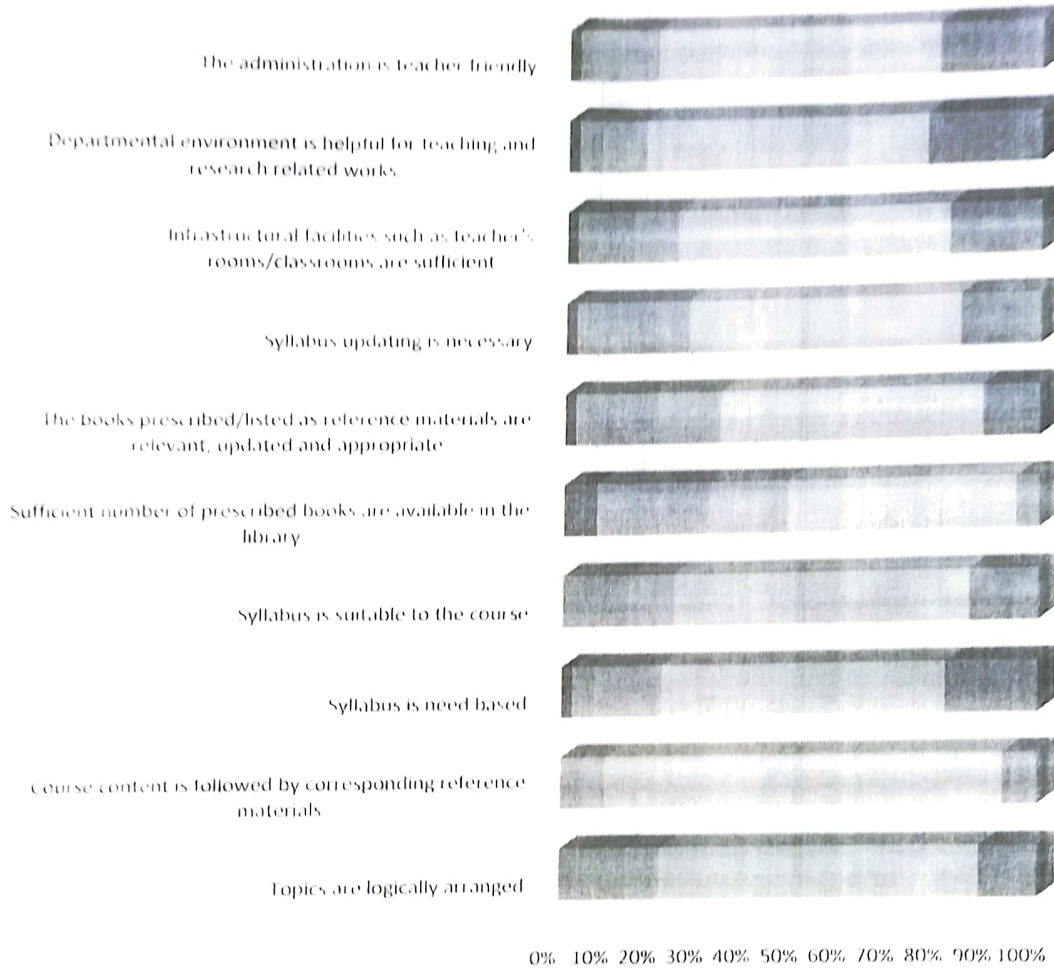

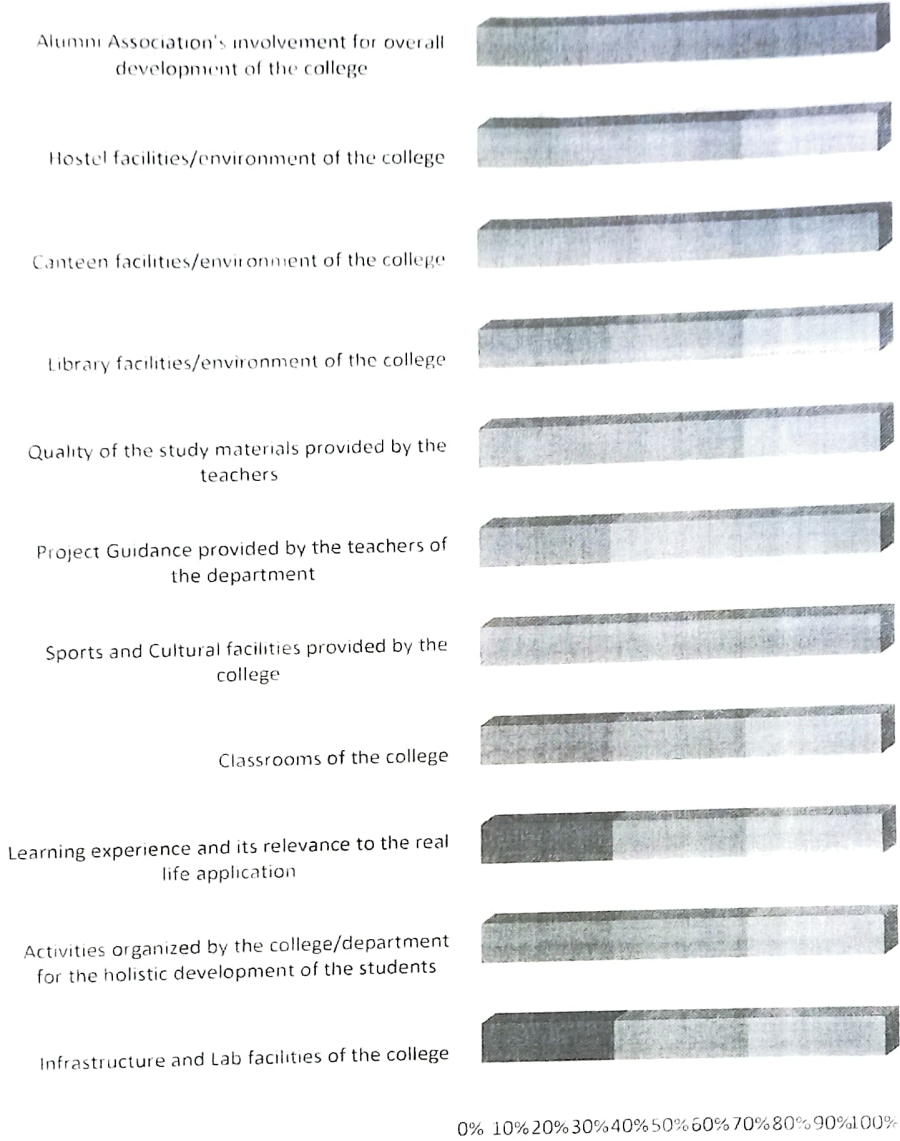
TEACHERS' FEEDBACK REPORT ON COURSE CURRICULAM
